Dr Erin (she/her) is a clinical psychologist who works with adolescents and adults, offering a warm, relaxed, and client-led approach to therapy.

She has experience across private, public health, hospital, school, and community settings, and supports clients with a range of presentations including neurodivergence, stress, anxiety, depression, relationship difficulties, grief and loss, trauma, adjustment challenges, obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD), and the psychological impacts of cancer and chronic illness. Erin also works with adolescents experiencing eating disorders, providing Family-Based Treatment (FBT) to support recovery within the family system.

Erin also conducts diagnostic assessments for children and adults including ADHD, ASD, ID, Specific Learning Difficulties, NDIS reports (access requests, early reviews and change of circumstances), and Centrelink reports.

Her approach is flexible and neuroaffirmative, drawing on evidence-based therapies including Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (ACT), Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT), Eye Movement Desensitisation and Reprocessing (EMDR), Schema Therapy, and mindfulness-based approaches.
